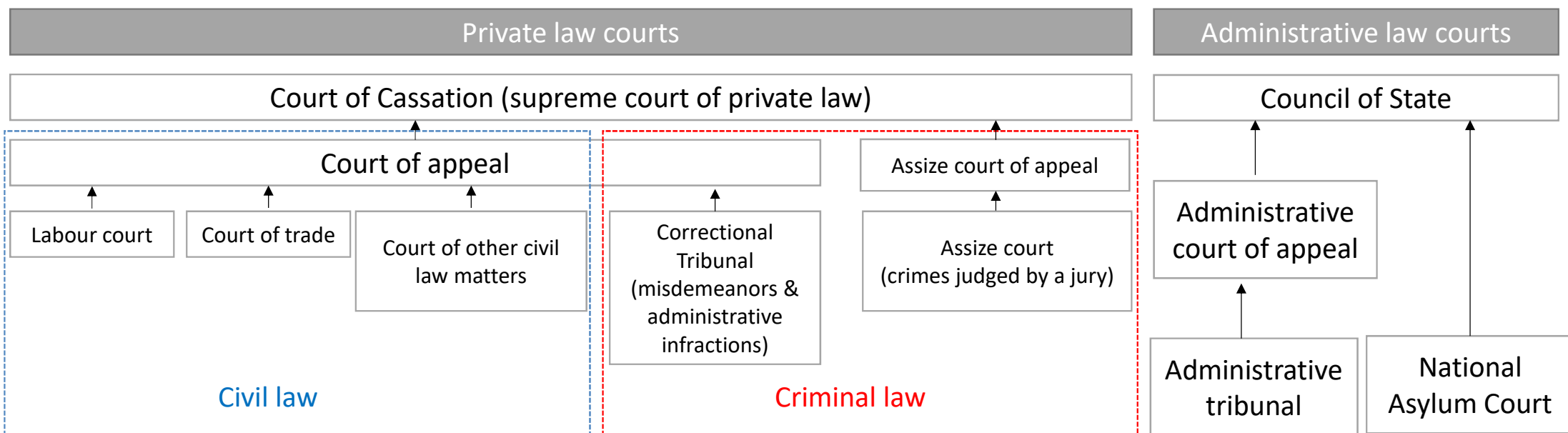


Administrative justice in France

Organization of the judiciary branch in France



La juridiction administrative



Le Conseil d'Etat

The Council of State is the supreme court of the administrative justice system. It can strike down decisions of the lower courts and thus ensure the consistency of administrative law precedent on a national level.



Administrative court of appeal

If a legal person wishes to appeal the tribunal's decision, his case will be brought before the court of appeal or, less often, before the Council of State.



Administrative tribunal

If a natural or juristic person wishes to bring a dispute with the administration before court, the administrative tribunal is the court of general and original jurisdiction.



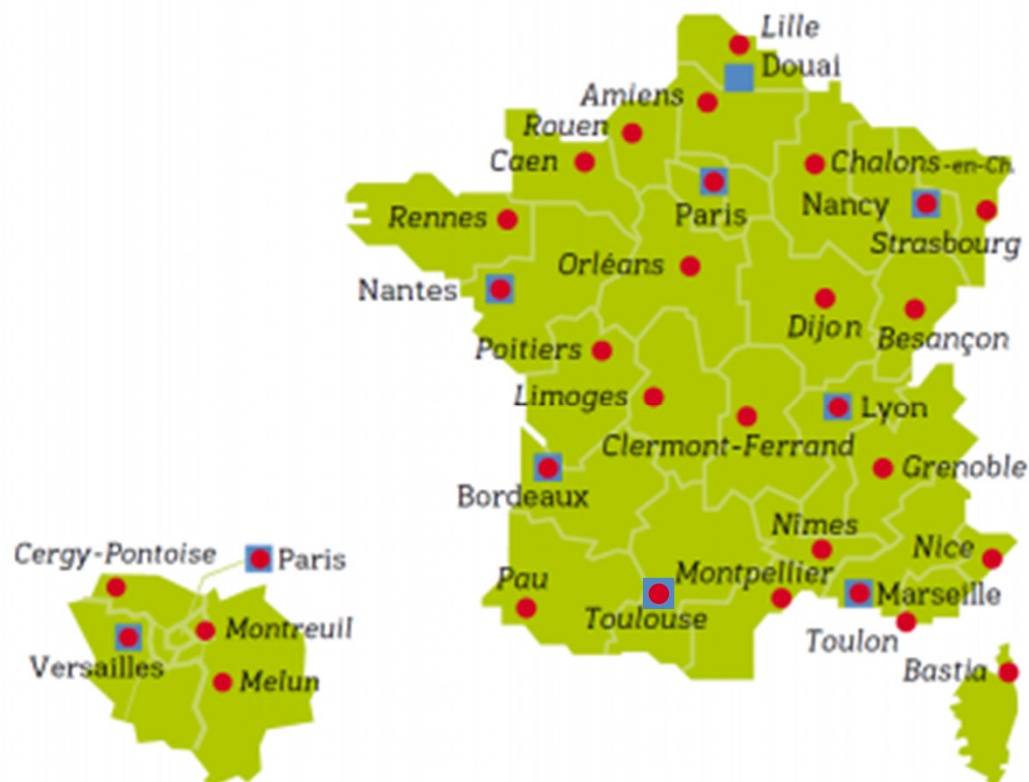

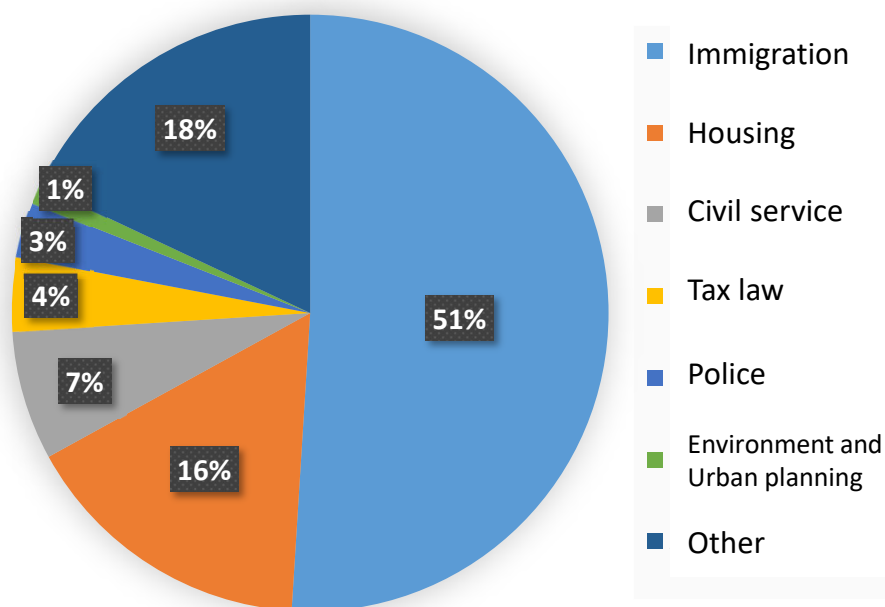

130 clerks and legal assistants

At a national level, **232 332** adjudicated cases. The Paris administrative tribunal adjudicates **11,79%** of the total number of cases brought before France's administrative tribunals.
